Central Library



The college boasts of a centrally situated well stocked library which aims to satisfy the academic needs of the faculty and the students. Its collection of selective books, Journals (National & International) CDs and Internet connectivity, meets the greater part of the student requirements of both learning & research interest. The library provides the following student support services.

The M.B.B.S. course is completely residential. Separate hostels are provided for boys and girls within the campus. The rooms are well ventilated and are on a twin sharing basis as well as Single Occupancy. Each student is provided with a cot, mattress, table, chair and almirah. Each Hostel has its own dinning hall, recreation room, visitors room & beautiful lawns. Water purifier and water cooler are also provided in the Mess to meet the requirements of the students.

Hostels





The main academic block of the college consists of a five storied building with a covered area of more than 10,00,000 sq. feet. It comprises of airconditioner lecture theatres equipped with modern teaching aids (OHP, interactive boards, LCD projectors), laboratories, museums, library & faculty chambers combined with contemporary architectural beauty & ideal space for academics & research.

OPD Block



A huge OPD complex has been provided with waiting lounge and separate reception counters for male & female patients. It caters to more than 2000 OPD patients daily. It has separate examination rooms, for all medical fields, separate dressing room, injection rooms, dark room, room for eye-testing, child rehabilitation room, child guidance room, immunization room, cancer clinic, maternity room, antenatal check up room, audiology room, EKG room etc. This block has 12 demonstration rooms for students teaching, on patients.





Emergency Block



For patients of accident, gun shot, Stab injury, poisoning, burn, serious illness, heart attack etc.

It has emergency operation theatre with emergency ward for male & female patients. The ward is provided with central oxygen and central suction along with crash cart, pulse oxymeters, non invasive blood pressure monitors & defibrillators, X-ray & Laboratory.

It also has 5 bedded Ventilator ICU with imported motorised ICU beds, Ventilators, defibrillator, Multi Power Monitors.

ICU and ICCU

A 26 bedded intensive care and intensive coronary care unit is available. This ward is fully air-conditioned with multiparameter monitors on each imported motorised electrical bed, defibrillators, ventilators, central nursing station, syringe pumps, infusion pumps etc. This unit also has TMT (stress test) and echo cardiography machine. Central oxygen, central suction and compressed air has been provided on each bed.

PICU

An air-conditioned 8 bedded paediatric intensive care unit is available for children. This unit has defibrillator, multiparameter monitors, central oxygen & suction, syringe pumps, infusion pumps, ventilators etc.

NICU

Two air-conditioned neonatal intensive care units are available, one for clean and one for infected cases. Each unit has 4 beds. It has infant ventilators, multiparameter monitors, infusion pumps, syringe pumps, photo therapy, radiant heat warmer etc.

RESPIRATORY ICU

An air-conditioned 5 bedded RICU is available with 3 ventilators. These beds have cardiac monitors, NIBP, Pulse Oxymeters, Syringe Pumps, Infusion Pumps, Defibrillators etc. Central oxygen, Central suction & compressed air is provided on all imported motorised beds.

BURN UNIT

This air-conditioned unit has 4 beds. Each bed is provided with cradles and emergency care system with multiparameter monitor.

DIALYSIS UNIT

A 3 bedded dialysis unit is also available.

WARDS

There are 600 general beds located in different blocks. All Major wards have nurses duty room, doctor duty room, procedure room, pantry and laboratory. All the duty rooms are well connected through EPABX lines to all other facilities.

Facilities



PRIVATE WARDS

36 private rooms are available. These have TV, Coolers, air-conditioners and amenities for patients comfort.

OPERATION THEATERS

13 operation theaters are functional at present. These operation theaters are air-conditioned and are fitted with most modern life saving equipments like imported operation lights (Hanau-lus-Germany), imported operation tables (Eschhman, UK), 'C' arm image intensifier (Philips) operating microscopes (Carl Ziess), imported anaesthesia machines (Ohmeda and Narcomed) with ventilators, anaesthesia gas monitors, oxygen monitors, pulse oxymeters, NIBP, General Surgical diathermy (Valleylab) along with central oxygen and central suction. Two theatres are modular.

DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SURGERY

It has facilities for all general operations, cancer operations, operations of plastic surgery, operations on gall bladder, abdominal operation, operation on oral cavity, limbs, face and other parts of the body. Laparoscopic surgery is also available for gall bladder and other diseases.

DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE

For all the patients of general diseases like fever, pain, TB, abdominal pain, weakness, cough etc. Facility for fibre optic endoscopy (gastroscopy) is also available. ECG is also available.

DEPARTMENT OF OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY

It has facilities for examination of pregnant women, CTG units, normal delivery, caesarian section, colposcopy, treatment of infertility, tubectomy, family planning laparoscopic diagnosis, laparoscopic surgery, internal bleeding, tumors of uterus, ovary etc.

IVF lab is also available.

DEPARTMENT OF ORTHOPAEDICS

It has facilities for treatment of Joint Pain, Sciatica, pain in neck and back, fracture, plaster and surgery using 'C' arm image intensifier. Hip replacement, Knee replacement, Spine Surgery, nailing planting etc is also available.

DEPARTMENT OF PAEDIATRICS

It has facilities for neonatal care and treatment of children of all ages. A 6 bedded modern nursery is also available.

DEPARTMENT OF OPHTHALMICS

It has facilities of testing of all eye diseases using latest machines like Ergovision eye tester, Topcon slitlamp, Tinsley perimeter, fundus camera, eye scan, indirect ophthalmoscope etc. Facilities for operations in eye for cataract, glaucoma squint is also available. Cataract operations are being done using Carl Zeiss and Carl Storz ophthalmic microscope and imported surgical design phaco machines. Facilities for A scan, B scan, fundus camera & laser surgery are also available.

DEPARTMENT OF SKIN & VENEREAL DISEASES

It has facilities for diagnosis and treatment of all skin and sexually transmitted diseases using lasers, UV chamber, etc.





DEPARTMENT OF ENT

It has facilities for diagnosis of diseases of ear, nose and throat. It has siemens audiology machine for testing of hearing capability, it has imported Microscope for operations of ear, nose and throat, Tympanoplasty, Mastoidectomy & Tonsillectomy etc. are being done.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEST & TUBERCULOSIS

It has facilities for diagnosis & treatment of chest diseases & respiratory problems. Pulmonary function test machine (PFT), pleuroscopy and bronchoscopy are also available.

DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY

It has facilities for diagnosis & treatment of mental and psychological disorders. Separate wards have been provided for such patients. Facilities for EEG, behavioural tests, ECT, etc. also available.

DEPARTMENT OF PATHOLOGY & MICROBIOLOGY

It has latest computerised machines and auto analysers for Testing of blood, culture, cytology, FNAC, biopsy etc. Elisa reader for hormonal assay, Cell counter and frozen section facilities are also available.

BLOOD BANK

An ultramodern blood banks has been established in the hospital for supply of quality blood & its components round the clock. It has all the facilities for testing of blood & modern equipments for blood donation.

DEPARTMENT OF RADIO DIAGNOSIS

It has 5 fixed X ray machines (two 500mA, one 800mA, two 300mA), two 100mA (Mobile) & six 30mA (Portable). X-ray facilities is available round the clock. Six color dopplers Ultrasound Units are available for quality diagnosis. 50 Slice High speed Spiral C.T. Scan facilities are also available. Digital fluroscopy and digital X-ray is also available. DSA, Mammography and latest open MRI (Hitachi 0.4 Tesla Aperto Lucent) & 1.5 Tesla Sciences Siemens Sempara M.R.I. also available.

OTHER FACILITIES

Three canteens, general store and mechanised laundry is also available in the hospital premises to provide food and other services to patients and their relatives as well as medical students.

MEDICAL STORE (HOSPITAL PHARMACY)

Seven big medical stores are available inside the hospital on different floors, which work round the clock and supply quality medicines at very economical price.

TRANSIT HOSTEL (like a guest house)

It is also available with in the campus. It has 27 AC rooms with dish TV, an air-conditioned conference room for 200 persons, canteen, food services etc. Parents of students are allowed to stay and use these facilities.

GENERAL FACILITIES

- A 512 lines EPABX system has been installed with telephones & intercoms in all departments, including X-ray, pathology emergency services, reception.
- A Public announcement system covers the whole hospital.
- All the reception areas & patient record system is fully computerised with the help of online computers.
- Hospital has a huge parking area, big beautiful lawns, own HT transformer and 6 generators to ensure 24 hours availability of power.
- 100 CCD cameras have been installed at all strategic places including all hospital corridors, all roads, lecture theatres, Hostels etc.

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Principal



The M.B.B.S. Course

The aim of the programme is to produce doctors who have learnt the need to :

- (1) Treat each patient with dignity, kindness, courtesy & respect.
- (2) Be competent in diagnosing and managing common health problems of the individual and community.
- (3) Serve the community through preventive medicine & education.
- (4) Appreciate the rationale for different therapeutic modalities & be familiar with the administration of “essential drugs” & their side effects.
- (5) Remain committed to continuing improvement in quality through adaptation of technological advance & continuing education.
- (6) Maintain the dignity of the Profession.
- (7) Recognize their responsibility to society and the development of traits such as personal integrity, sense of responsibility, dependability & ability to relate to & show concern for other individuals.

Duration

Four & a half years (4½ yrs) plus one year compulsory rotatory internship. Candidates admitted to MBBS course must pass all papers of first professional MBBS examination, within four attempts (the four attempts are to be completed within 3 yrs from the date of enrolment). If they fail to do so, they will not be allowed to continue the course.

Eligibility

- (a) Age : The candidate should have completed 17yrs of age on 31st December of the year preceding the year in which admission is sought.
- (b) Qualifying exam : The candidate should have passed 10+2 or equivalent with English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology. Scoring a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology subjects & Shall have qualified NEET Examination.

Admission

Admission to M.B.B.S. Course is through National Eligibility & Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by the Government of India For further details and admission enquiry contact at 0581-2526053, 2526051, 9557259598

Uniform

The dress code for boys & girls in the college has to be strictly followed as prescribed. Apron with identity card (white full sleeves) must be worn in the classes, dissection hall, laboratories & hospital postings.

Fee & Mode of Payment

College Fee : As per directive received from the Government of India/State Government/Honourable courts/Committee.



Payment of annual fee, examination fee and other fees should be as per payment schedule.

An extra examination fee will be charged per attempt per subject, may it be due to detention, full absence or failure in any professional exam.

Note : All fees are non-refundable. As per the order of honourable Supreme Court.

Academic Detail

1. ATTENDANCE

75% in theory & 80% in Practical / Clinical posting in each subject is the requirement as per Medical Council of India. Any student falling short of attendance will be detained from taking part in professional university examination.

Absence from theory / practical examination will be treated as absent even if there is a Doctors certificate for illness.

2. DAY TO DAY ASSESSMENT / TUTORIALS & SEMINARS

These include assignments, diagram making write ups, short orations. In addition departmental examination, terminal examination & viva voce are conducted from time to time. The performance in these will be the basis of internal assessment and will have a weightage of 20% of the total marks of each subject in the professional examination conducted by the university. 50% marks in the internal assessment are mandatory to make a student eligible to appear in the University exam as per MCI rules.

Recreational And Sports Facility

There are facilities for indoor & outdoor Games, Gymnasium & Yoga cricket, Football, Basket ball, Volleyball.

Rules & Regulations

1. All students shall comply with the Rules and Regulations of the college / hospital.
2. The following are strictly forbidden in the campus of the college / hospital.
 - i) Motor Cycle / Scooter / Car to any student.
 - ii) The possession or use of alcoholic beverages and tobacco.

- iii) The possession or use of addictive or hallucinogenic drugs.
 - iv) Gambling or betting
 - v) The possession or use of any firearms or lethal weapon.
 - vi) Any Unlawful and Anti-social activity.
 - vii) Cellular/Mobile phones in college area.
 - viii) Smoking & Chewing Paan or Tobacco.
 - ix) Spitting
3. As per the ruling of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the guidelines notified by the Government of India, ragging is strictly prohibited and punishable in the form of expulsion, suspension or fine with a public apology.
 4. Dignity of profession is to be maintained at all times. Use of vulgar, offensive and undignified language is strictly prohibited.
 5. Hippocrates oath has to be taken by each student regarding medical ethics.
 6. Students will have to pay for all damages caused by them to any college / hostel property.
 7. College Timings– Class Timings are to be strictly followed.

No student shall be allowed to enter the college campus after college hours unless there are written instruction from the Principal / Administration officer.

Hostel rules & regulations are to be followed strictly.

8. Dress Code as prescribed by the college must be strictly adhered to and followed during class timings. In addition each student is required to wear a white apron at all times during classes (theory + practical / clinical postings) with a badge displaying the name of the student.
9. Hostel is mandatory for all students.

Ist Year : General-Human Anatomy & Histology, Physiology, Bio-Chemistry & Dental Materials.

IIInd Year : General Pharmacology & Therapeutics, General Pathology & Microbiology, Dental Anatomy & Histology, Pre-Clinical Conservative Dentistry, Pre-clinical Prosthodontics, Crown & Bridge work.

IIIrd Year : General Medicine, General Surgery, Oral Pathology, Preventive & Community Dentistry.

The Syllabus



IVth Year : Oral Medicine & Radiology, Periodontics, Pedodontics and Orthodontics, Prosthodontics, Conservative dentistry and Endodontics & Oral Surgery.

Internship is required now as per DCI regulations.



Eligibility for Admission

Admission to the five years B.D.S. Course shall be through a competitive Examination (NEET) held by the Government of India and through Common Counseling by U.P. Government.

All candidates desirous of seeking admission must obtain atleast 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in Intermediate or 10+2 or equivalent examination. For SC/ST, the minimum marks in Intermediate or equivalent examination shall be 40%.

For further details, please contact the Administrative Officer of the Institute on any working day between 10.00 a.m. - 2.00 p.m. (Phone : 0581-2526244, 3096688, 2526051, 2526053, 9359102935).

- A student who stands first in aggregate in 1st, 2nd, 3rd and final examination of the Institute (with a minimum of 75% marks) shall be awarded a Gold Medal.
- A student who stands second in aggregate in 1st, 2nd, 3rd and final examination of the Institute shall be awarded a Silver Medal.
- A student who tops in aggregate of all the four examinations shall be declared as the "Best Graduate" and be awarded a Gold Medal. Such a student must pass all the annual examinations in first attempt and without a gap.

Medals / Scholarships



- A prize for "Excellence in Clinical Work" shall be awarded to one of the final year students on the recommendation of committee comprising the Heads of clinical dental subjects.
- In addition to the above, a certain number of poor and deserving students may be awarded scholarship or some concession in tuition fee by Managing Committee on the recommendation of Academic Council of the Institute.

Admission Procedures

(As per INC & State Nursing Council norms)

1. NPCC Programme (2 Years):

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ Applicants must possess a registered B.Sc./PBBS nurse with a minimum of one year clinical experience, preferably in any critical care setting prior to enrolment.
 - ◆ Must have undergone the B.Sc. in an institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
 - ◆ Must have scored not less than 55% aggregate marks in the B.Sc program
- Selection must be based on the merit of an entrance examination and interview held by the competent authority.

2. M.Sc. Nursing (2 Years):

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ The candidate should be a registered nurse and registered midwife or equivalent with any state nursing registration council.
- ◆ The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc Nursing/B.ScHons. Nursing/post basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- ◆ The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing/B.ScHons. Nursing/post basic B.Sc nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- ◆ Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. nursing.
- ◆ Minimum one year of work experience prior or after post basic B.Sc. nursing.
- ◆ Candidate shall be medically fit.
- ◆ 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.



3. Basic B. Sc. Nursing (4 Years):

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ The minimum age for admission shall be 17years on 31stDecember of the year in which admission is sought.
- ◆ Minimum Educational Qualification:
 - A candidate should have pass in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45 % marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination.
 - Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by the State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science Subjects and English only.
 - English is a compulsory subject in 10 + 2.
- ◆ Candidate shall be medically fit. However, Colour Blind candidate should be considered admission in Nursing Courses subject to the condition that Colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
- ◆ Candidate shall be admitted once in a year.
- ◆ Reservation Policy:

- For disabled candidate 5% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 45% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for each nursing programme.
- Admission under the reserved quota shall be subject to reservation policy and eligibility criteria for SC/ST/OBC/PH/EWSs prescribed by the Central Government/ State Government/ Union Territory as applicable to the College concern.
- Reservation SC/St, OBC or any other shall be as per the Central Government/ State Government rules as applicable.

Note: Reservation shall be applicable within the sanctioned number of the seats.

4. General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) (3 Years):

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ Minimum and maximum age for admission will be 17 and 35 years. There is no age bar for ANM/LHV
- ◆ Minimum education:

- ◆ 10+2 vocational ANM under CBSE board or other equivalent board from the school and recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- ◆ Registered as ANM with state nursing registration council.
- ◆ Students shall be medically fit.
- ◆ Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination or health care science-vocational stream ONLY conducted by National institute of open school.
- ◆ Student shall be admitted once in a year.
- ◆ 5% of total marks is relaxed for SC/ST candidates

5. Auxiliary Nursing & Midwifery (ANM), (2 Years):

Eligibility Criteria:

- ◆ The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- ◆ The maximum age for admission shall be 30 years.
- ◆ The minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 in arts (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Sciences, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home science, Sociology, Psychology, and Philosophy) and English core/English elective or science, or health care science-vocational stream only passing out from recognized board.
- ◆ Student shall be medically fit.
- ◆ Students qualified in 10+2 arts or science examination conducted by National Institute of open School.
- ◆ Student shall be admitted once in a year

Entrance/Selection Test:

Selection of the candidate should be based on the merit of the entrance examination held by university or competent authority.

Verification of Documents:

The copies of the required certificate should be attached with the application form for verification.

Medical Examination:

Medical examination of the selected candidates will be conducted by the Medical board of RMCH.

Withdrawal from the course:

If, after taking admission, the student withdraws from the course, the balance course fees for remaining year/ years of the course has to be deposited before leaving the course.

Migration to other Institution/ College:

No application for migration to other Institution/ College will be entertained from students admitted to this College till the completion of the courses.

Examination Rules & Regulation

1. NPCC:

Attendance:

- ◆ The student is required to attend all the lectures and practical of every subject and also the curricular and co-curricular activities and not absent himself/ herself without valid reasons.
- ◆ A student must have 100% attendance in theory and practical of each subject.
- ◆ This is a full time course and no student is permitted to engage in any clinic/ laboratory / nursing home during the study period.
- ◆ Any student who fails to comply in the manner stated above shall not be permitted to appear for the University Examinations.

Examinations:

- ◆ In an academic year two university examinations shall be conducted.
- ◆ The main examination shall be held at the end of the academic year and the other examination supplementary examination will be conducted within two months of declaration of main examination result.
- ◆ A student shall be allowed to appear in final year examination only after submission of dissertation
- ◆ The maximum duration permitted to complete the course is four years and he/ she is permitted to have two attempts for a subject.

Qualifying standards:

- ◆ A student is declared pass in a subject provided he/she score 60% or above.
- ◆ The marks obtained in the University examination and in the internal assessment of the subject shall be added to compute subject percentage.

II. B.Sc.Nursing:

Attendance:

- ◆ Each student is normally required to attend all the lectures and practical of every subject as also the curricular and co-curricular activities.
- ◆ A student must have minimum 80% attendance in theory and practical of each subject for appearing in the examination. In special circumstances, short fall in attendance can be condoned on case's merit to the extent of 10% by the Principal. If the short fall is more than 10% but not more than 15%, the Principal may recommend on case's merit to the Vice Chancellor for condonation. The order of Vice Chancellor shall be final.
- ◆ A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of practical area before award of degree.

Examinations:

- ◆ In an academic year two university examinations shall be conducted. The main examination shall be held at the end of the academic year and the other examination- auxiliary examination will be conducted within two months of declaration of main examination result.
- ◆ All practical examinations must be held in the respective clinical areas. Maximum number of candidate for practical examination should not exceed 20 per day.
A student shall be allowed to appear in final year examination only after completion of internship subject to he/ she has passed/ cleared all the subject of previous three parts
- ◆ A student not qualified in the theory or practical, shall be required to re-appear in both theory and practical examination. In such cases, internal assessment of the subject (theory and/or practical) can be revised based on test/ standup examination conducted.
- ◆ On completion of internship, internal assessment out of 100 marks should be sent to the university for Inclusion in the mark sheet.

Qualifying Standards:

- ◆ Minimum pass marks for each theory and practical subject shall be 50%. The marks obtained in the University examination and in the internal assessment of the subject shall be added to compute subject percentage.
- ◆ Candidate must pass in internal and external examinations in each of the paper separately.
- ◆ The qualifying marks for English subject shall be 40%.
The subject Environmental Studies shall be a qualifying subject and marks obtained in this subject shall not be the included in the total marks of end term. However student a required to score 20 marks in total of university examination and internal assessment to qualify.

III. GNM:

Examination Guidelines:

- ◆ Shall have one regular examination followed by supplementary examination in a year.
- ◆ If a candidate fails they can be promoted to next year.
- ◆ A candidate can take any number of attempts with a condition that maximum period allowed is 6 years. However all previous papers need to be cleared before appearing in the final examination.
- ◆ Maximum pass marks should be 50% in each of the Theory and practical paper separately.
- ◆ Minimum pass marks shall be 40% for English only.
- ◆ A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
- ◆ If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to re appear for both papers (Theory and Practical)

Eligibility for Admission to Examination:

A candidate shall be eligible for the admission to the state Council / Board examination if the Principle of the school certificate that:

- ◆ She/he has completed not less than eleven months of the course.
- ◆ A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing in the examination.
- ◆ A candidate must secure 50% marks in internal assessment separately in each theory and practical.
- ◆ The record of practical experience is complete.
- ◆ (The Principal shall send to the Council/board the internal assessment for each subject is. both theory and practical (s) before the start of the examination along with the examination form).

IV.ANM:

Eligibility for Admission to Examination

- ◆ A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.
- ◆ A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before the award of completion certificate/diploma by the state nursing council examination board.
- ◆ On completion of practical experience, records to be signed by the tutor and counter signed by the principal.
- ◆ The examination for the 21nd year should happen at the end of the year. A certificate of completion of internship by each student should be provided by the principal before entering for the examinations.

ANM Examination Guidelines:

- ◆ Shall have one regular examination followed by supplementary examination in a year.
- ◆ No candidate shall be permitted to appear in the second year examination unless the candidate has passed the first year examination.
- ◆ Maximum duration of completion of course is 4 years.
- ◆ Pass mark for each subject on aggregate will be 50%
- ◆ A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper. Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.

Class rules & regulation:



Students are instructed to follow the rules & regulation as given below:

- ◆ Punctuality in attending class.
- ◆ Avoid coming in the class after the teacher's entry.
- ◆ Not to go to canteen in between the lecture periods.
- ◆ The students should maintain strict silence during the lecture.

7. Prior permission from Nursing Superintendent must obtain for visiting sick students or relatives.
8. The students should be in proper uniform, ID, shoes, ba/no beard, well groomed, proper haircut.
9. For girls no ear rings, bangle, proper combed hair.
10. The students should have the pocket articles their clinical duties.
11. The students should complete their clinical requirement on their particular ward itself during their posting.
12. While in duty, no student is allowed to leave the ward. The student should enter in movement register while go out of ward for lab/ pharmacy/ other wards with the permission of ward incharge.
13. Every student is supposed to wear prescribed uniform while in the clinical posting.
14. Wearing of ID is compulsory.
15. Clinical experience timing has to be observed strictly.
16. Emergency call days ward clinical experience can be fixed by the concerned authorities as per the need, without extra obligation.
17. Use of mobile phones is not allowed in college hours or clinical posting. If any students found using mobile phones will be fined for Rs. 500/ and mobile will be given back after the completion of course.
18. On no account students should absent themselves from ward and other assigned duties. Strict action will be taken for absenteeism.
19. Students will be graded according to their performance, judged by Principal/ Vice Principal.
20. No student is allowed for any kind of clinical service outside the hospital.
21. No student shall take part in political movement or activity in the hospital campus/ college.
22. Students will not be called from the wards to visit the Parents/Guardian/Relatives or Friends until it is an extreme emergency.
23. Parents/ Guardians/Relatives or Friends are not allowed to visit the Students in the wards.
24. Whenever any relative of the Students are admitted in the wards or has to come to O.P.D. to consult the Doctors, the Students should take the written permission from the Principal/Vice-Principal or Sister Tutors.
25. Students are not allowed to leave the hostel until the prior permission by the Parents/ Guardian is taken from College authorities at least a week earlier.
26. Students will be allowed for night stays outside hostel with Parents or Guardian accompanying them only after taking prior permission from college authorities.
27. To all the above the Discretionary power rests with the Authorities.
28. Management/ Principal/ Vice Principal/ Medical Superintendent reserve the right to change any rules/regulation at any time.
29. Student should remain in the respective ward N.S., student in-charge have the right to change the ward with transfer slip.

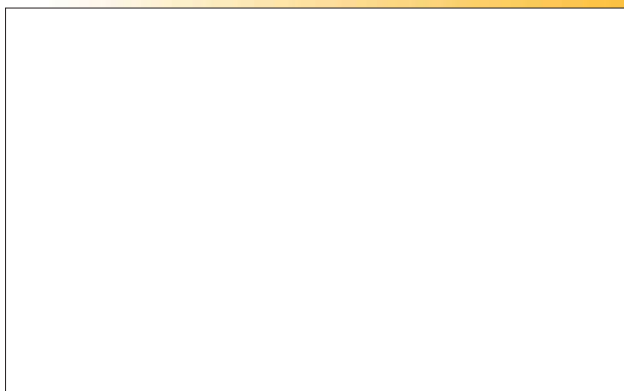
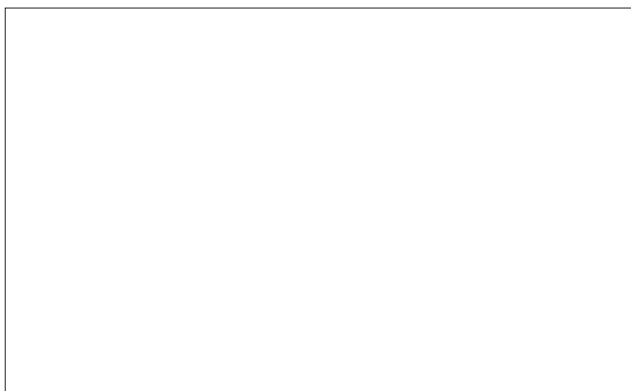

- ◆ Cost of all medications and investigation will be borne by the students.
- ◆ Security checks (personal and other) may be carried out by the security staff at any time.
- ◆ Any act of misconduct/ indiscipline will invite disciplinary action.
- ◆ No Student shall take part in political movement or activity in the hospital campus.
- ◆ Management/Principal/Medical superintendent reserve the right to change any rules / regulations at any time.

HOSTEL RULES & REGULATIONS:

These rules are meant for smooth functioning of Rohilkhand College/School of Nursing. The entire students are expected to follow these, in spirit:

- ◆ The rooms will be allotted to the students by the concerned authority only. No student is allowed to change his/her room without prior permission.

- ◆ Student should reach before 7:00 pm to hostel there after no entry is allowed.

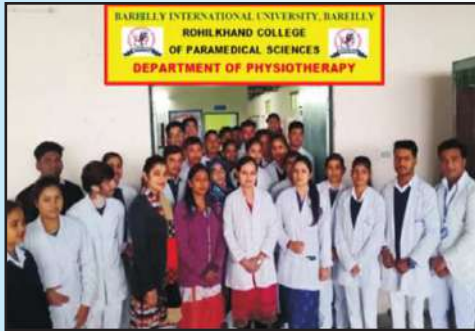

The Master of Hospital Administration programme (MHA-Hospital) aims to develop a cadre of professional managers for the rapidly growing hospital sector. As hospitals become an increasingly complex technical environment employing people with widely divergent skills, the need to manage them efficiently without any compromise to the humane and caring environment that the sick need brings forth the need for a new type of health professional- the hospital manager. The MHA (Hospital) programme prepares students for leadership roles in the hospital sector through training in planning, operational and project management of hospitals including orientation in the managerial aspects of clinical and support services. The programme also imparts training in managing financial, material and information systems in hospital settings and builds the perspectives, attitudes and skills needed for managing people. General Rules & Regulations

1. Every student will be issued an Identity Card.
2. (a) Every student is expected to maintain 100% attendance in both, Theory & Practical Classes.
(b) Any Student, who fails to maintain minimum 80% of attendance, he/she will not be allowed to appear for internal or Professional Examinations as per guidelines of various Councils/ University.
3. (a) The student must pay his/her fee before the start of the Academic Year. All the fees are non refundable.
(b) In case the student does not pay the fee in time then, late fee of Rs. 100/- per day will be levied as fine for next 30 days. Further if he is not able to pay fee then his admission may be cancelled.
4. Any damage to College/ Hospital property will be recovered from the concerned student in addition to fine imposed.
5. Holidays of the college are to be followed as per the college Academic Calendar.
6. Following are prohibited in the hostel as well as in college and campus:-
 - (a) Two or four wheeler vehicles are not permitted inside the campus of college and hostels. If any of these items founds then it will be confiscated and will not be returned at any cost. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in class rooms, labs or hospital area.
 - (b) Smoking Materials like; Cigarettes, Cigars etc.
 - (c) Any form of Drugs and Alcoholic drinks.
 - (e) Paan/ Paan Masala
 - (f) Only Walkman, Tape Radio, Two-in-One are allowed. VCP-VCR Video etc. will be confiscated.
 - (g) Students should not keep any costly item in the Hostel. In case of loss/ theft of any such item Warden or Hostel Staff will not be responsible.
 - (h) Any kind of Arms and Ammunitions.
 - (i) Materials which are fire-prone e.g. Kerosene, Petrol, Stove Elect. Iron/ Heater etc.
 - (j) Playing Cards, Gambling or Betting in any form.
 - (k) Any Unlawful and Anti-Social activity.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED

- (a) Two or four wheeler vehicles inside the campus and hostels & mobile phones in the academic areas.
- (b) Any type of Quarrelling/ Fighting/ Shouting/ Abusing/ Whistling & use of vulgar or uncivilized language.
- (c) Any type of Cooking in Rooms, Lobbies, Balconies, Verandah or in open space.
- (d) Carrying meals and utensils from mess to rooms or throwing edibles in verandah.



- (e) Shifting of any item from one room to another room.
- (f) Going outside the hostel building after 7:00 P.M. for girls and 8:00 PM for boys without permission from the warden.
- (g) Use of room heaters/ Electric Iron etc.

RAGGING

Ragging is completely prohibited and is cognizable offence as per the order of Honourable Supreme Court of India, as recommended by the Committee constituted by the Government of India, under the Chairmanship of Shri R.K. Raghavan, Former Director, CBI; on Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. It should be clearly understood that ragging is cognizable, non-bailable, non-compoundable offence with punishment.

Broadly Ragging can be categorized in the following ways :

- A. Verbal : Where senior causes mental harassment, discomfort for the junior by forcing him/her to answer unacceptable / personal questions, dance, singing etc. is said to rag the junior. It also includes within its ambit cyber ragging and the like.
- B. Serve Verbal Ragging : Where the mental harassment, discomfort it to such an act as forces the junior to withdraw from the college or do physical harm to himself/herself.
- C. Physical : Any act by the senior towards the junior which inflicts or causes to inflict bodily injury on the junior, like beating the junior, hitting him/her with objects etc.
- D. Sexual Ragging : Where the senior asks the junior to do an act which damages sexual dignity of the junior or any act incidental to it.

PUNISHMENT

The following could be the possible punishment for those who are found guilty of participating in or abetment of ragging. The quantum of punishment shall, naturally, depend upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Disciplinary Committee of college or the court of law.

- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- 5. Withholding results.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- 7. Suspension expulsion from the hostel.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 10. Fine upto Rs. 25,000/-
- 11. Rigorous imprisonment upto seven years with fine.

- 2. Detailed affidavits/ undertakings will have to be signed by all students & parents on above matters at the time of admission and at the beginning of each academic year.
