On 3rd January 2025, the Department of Orthopedics, Rohilkhand Medical College & Hospital (RMCH), Bareilly, had the privilege of hosting **Dr. Suresh Chand**, Associate Professor of Pediatric Orthopedics, **King George Medical College, Lucknow**, as a distinguished guest lecturer.

Dr. Chand delivered an enlightening talk on “**My Quest for Bone Union: Managing Congenital Pseudoarthrosis of Tibia in Children.**” The session, held at LT-10, was attended by faculty, postgraduate students, and interns, who gained valuable insights into one of the most challenging problems in pediatric orthopedics.



Drawing on his vast clinical experience and research, Dr. Chand shared innovative surgical and non-surgical approaches to achieve bone union in children. He also highlighted his work on the Ponseti method for clubfoot treatment and his Hindi book “**Club Foot: A Guide for Parents,**” aimed at empowering families with knowledge and practical guidance.

The Department of Orthopedics, RMCH, extended heartfelt gratitude to Dr. Chand for his valuable contribution to academic and clinical learning.

On 5th May 2025, the department hosted a **guest lecture** on IUI by **Dr. Ritu Chauhan**, a distinguished member of RISA IVF. The lecture was highly informative and provided valuable insights into multiple aspects of the procedure. It covered the factors influencing IUI outcomes, indications, prerequisites, ovarian stimulation protocols, and methods for monitoring the IUI cycle. Additionally, various case discussions and study reviews offered eye-opening perspectives and greatly enriched our knowledge.



Guest Lecture: Dr. K.C.Gupta

The Department of Pediatrics, RMCH, Bareilly, organized a guest lecture on 26th June 2025 on “An Interesting Case of Inborn Error of Metabolism (IEM),” delivered by Dr. K.C. Gupta. Dr. Preeti Lata Rai welcomed the speaker and highlighted his expertise. Dr. Gupta presented a rare case of urea cycle disorder, emphasizing diagnostic challenges, key biochemical investigations, and management strategies including emergency care, dietary therapy, and genetic counseling. The interactive session engaged residents and postgraduates, enhancing clinical reasoning. Faculty appreciated the clarity and relevance. The event concluded with a token of appreciation and calls for dedicated metabolic clinics.

WORKSHOP: Focus on POCUS

The Department of Anaesthesia, Rohilkhand Medical College and Hospital, Bareilly, organized a **Workshop on “Focus on POCUS in Anaesthesia and Critical Care”** on **29th June 2025** at LT-9. The workshop aimed to train faculty, postgraduate students, and residents in the use of Point of Care Ultrasound (POCUS) for bedside assessment and procedures, with the objective of integrating POCUS into routine clinical practice for improved patient care. Advanced OLLIF Trans-Kambin Fusion Course

The Department of Orthopedics, Rohilkhand Medical College & Hospital (RMCH), successfully organized the Advanced OLLIF Trans-Kambin Fusion Course on 14–15 July 2025, marking a landmark in minimally invasive spine surgery education. The program was led by Course Director **Dr. Hamid Abbasi (USA)**, Organising Chairman **Dr. Karthik K. Kailash**, and Organising Secretary **Prof. Dr. Varun Kumar Agarwal**.

Over 80 delegates from India and countries including Sri Lanka, South Africa, Egypt, Iraq, Malaysia, Nepal, Congo, and Iran participated, benefiting from interactive lectures, live surgical demonstrations, and cadaveric workshops on the advanced OLLIF technique.

In the past three years, it has performed over 1,000 surgeries and treated 1,500+ patients with advanced radiotherapy using TrueBeam STx LINAC and modern brachytherapy. The Nuclear Medicine Unit, led by Dr. Ankit Kumar, has completed 2,500+ PET-CT scans and is expanding with a Gamma Camera, Bone Marrow



Transplant facility, and High-Dose Therapy Unit.

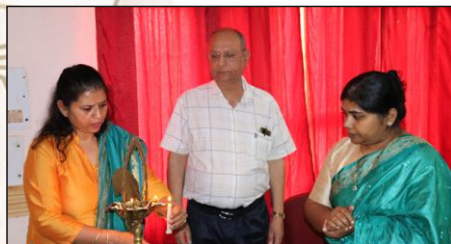

42nd UPAOICON-2025

The 42nd Annual Conference of the Association of Otolaryngologists of India, UP Chapter (UPAOICON-2025), was held from September 19–21, 2025, at Rohilkhand Medical College & Hospital, Bareilly, with over 350 delegates in attendance. The event featured comprehensive sessions ranging from ENT basics to advanced head & neck cancer and skull base surgeries.

Day one began with hands-on cadaveric dissections in Temporal Bone, Thyroplasty, and FESS, along with video sessions and courses on Allergy Testing, Vertigo, FEES, and Sialoendoscopy. Renowned speakers included Dr. Anil K. D'Cruz (Prof. S.R. Singh Oration), Dr. Ashok Gupta (Prof. R.N. Mishra Oration), and Dr. Rajesh Yadav (Prof. Y.C. Yadav Oration). Keynote addresses were delivered by Dr. M.K. Taneja on "Mahendra Maneuver in Sinusitis and Eustachian Tube Dysfunction" and Dr. Mubarak Khan on "Two-handed Endoscopic Techniques in Cholesteatoma."

Enhancing diagnostics with the new BD Pheonix system

The department of Microbiology is delighted to announce the installation of BD Phoenix automated ID/AST system in January 2025 that shall strengthen the laboratory diagnosis of infectious diseases. The BD Phoenix is an automated system that provides rapid and accurate microbial identification and antimicrobial susceptibility testing (AST) results for bacteria and yeasts. The system uses specialized BD Phoenix™ panels and performs a battery of biochemical tests for accurate identification of pathogenic microorganisms. It also determines minimum inhibitory concentration (MIC) by using doubling dilutions of antibiotic concentrations which helps in selection of most appropriate antibiotic especially in critical care patients. Along with providing faster results, the BD Pheonix system will also aid in clinical decisions to combat emerging antimicrobial resistance and to improve patient care.



“A New Milestone in Reproductive Health: IVF Centre at RMCH

We understand that infertility can be an emotional and challenging journey. IVF Centre of RMCH has been at the forefront of providing world-class infertility care, helping couples to achieve their dreams of parenthood.

Achievements and Milestones:

Our IVF centre was established in 2022 with the vision of providing ethical and patient centered fertility care. Over a short span of time, we have helped numbers of families to grow. The centre offers advanced assisted reproductive technologies by a multidisciplinary team of reproductive medicine specialists, embryologists, nurses and technicians who form the backbone of the center. From genetic screening (PGT-A) to cryopreservation, we continuously integrate the latest advancements to improve treatment

Since its inception, 37 cycles of IVF + ET with 12 positive results of which 7 delivered, including two triplets, have been performed. The first baby was born on 21 June, 2023. 48 IUI with 5 positive results, all of which delivered, have been conducted. Multiple successful ovulation induction cycles have been performed.



Our centre remains committed to advancing reproductive medicine while prioritizing patient care and outcomes.

MY GOLDEN DAYS AT RMCH, BAREILLY

4. Stay humble and kind to everyone around. Once you begin practising, no patient asks your rank. They only remember you for the the human you were and how you made them feel.

I was always a very ordinary student but I always had an extra ordinary desire to do something worthwhile in life - which I myself could be proud of.

I want to end with the lines that kept me moving through both MBBS and PG preparation whenever I doubted myself:

***“Kaun kehta hai asmaan mein suraakh nahin ho sakta,

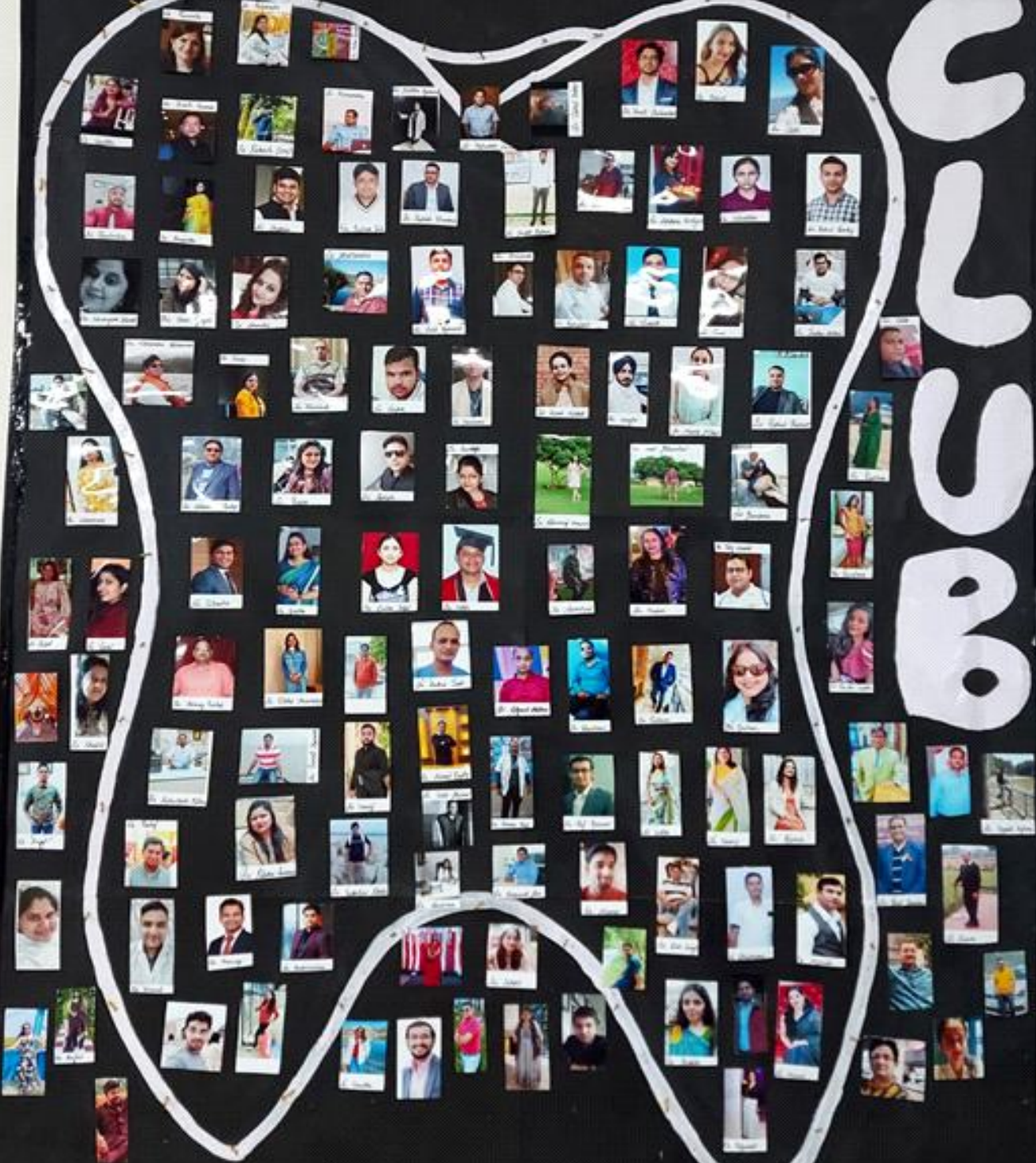

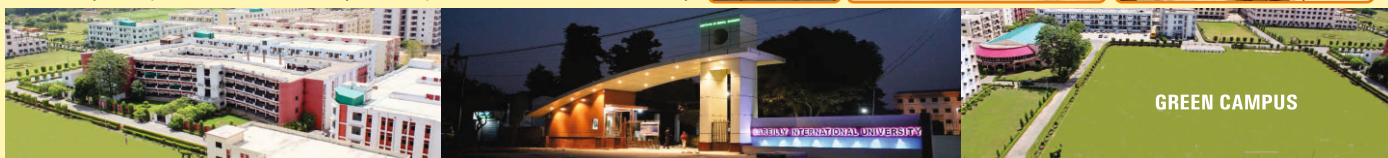
